#### **Transportation:**

- Metro Rail: Smithsonian station on the Blue/Orange line. The Independence Avenue exit is at Wing 1, in front of the USDA South Building.
- From the south side of Independence Avenue, enter Wing 7 at the end of the building. The Jefferson Auditorium is between Wing 5 and Wing 7. [Click here](#) to plan your travel by metro.
- Parking: Limited parking is available on Jefferson Drive on the Mall, a short block north of Independence Avenue. Jefferson Drive is one-way from west to east. Underground parking is available at 550 12th Street, about 2 blocks south of the South Building.

## Security Requirements:

- The Jefferson Auditorium is in a secured building and your access within the building will be limited to certain areas. Anyone who does not have a USDA government ID should plan to arrive early to get through security.
- You will need a photo ID to enter the building.
- The fewer materials you bring, the easier it will be to process through security.
- Laptops need to be signed in and out. For this process, you will need the serial number and model. Plan extra time if you must bring a laptop.
- You will receive a symposium name badge once inside the building. You must wear your name badge at all times inside the building.
- The audience will have cafeteria privileges, and rest rooms are located close to the Jefferson Auditorium.
- Persons not having an official USDA government ID cannot go outside these rest room and cafeteria boundaries. If they do, they will be asked to leave the premises and not allowed to return to the symposium at any time.

## Meals/Breaks:

Meals are on your own. You will have access to the cafeteria, which will open at 6:30 a.m. Some light refreshments are provided at most break times.
